Journey into the heart of Māori culture for an experience you will never forget! Te Pā Tū celebrates seasonal kai (food) and Māori culture. Te Pā Tū shares a four-hour evening feast aligned to and changing with the maramataka (Māori lunar calendar). For Māori, kai is integral to any special gathering, so you'll experience the mystical Ahi Taitai (fire ceremony) before stepping in to the tawa forest canopy for seasonal kai horotai (canapés) and a lantern-lit walk to a lavish three-course family-share hākari (feast).

Tū Te Ihi references the energy and passion stirred by the Matariki cluster and the promise they herald. Tū Te Ihi celebrates a moment in the earth's cycle when the stars of Matariki (Pleiades) draw our attention. Matariki conjures our ancestors as we recall their legacy, and reflect on the year that has been.

Feast on song, drama, tradition, and divine seasonal kai (cuisine) within our forest Pā (village) –blanketed by towering Tawa trees, blazing bonfires, and forest-formed amphitheatre.

Te Pā Tū shares Māori history, traditions, and cultural aspirations across 4-hours of celebration and feasting. These events change with each season of the maramataka, the Māori lunar calendar.

Waimangu Volcanic Valley is one of Rotorua's premier tourist attractions and a must-do experience for anyone looking for unique eco-tours that take in incredible geothermal features and rare plants. The valley, which is a protected scenic reserve and wildlife refuge set in pristine New Zealand bush, was created in 1886 when Mt Tarawera erupted. The historic event destroyed the surrounding area and opened the earth along a 17km rift, splitting Mt Tarawera in two, exploding Lake Rotomahana to 20 times its size- and forming the seven craters that make up the valley today. Within 15 years of the volcanic eruption, the hot springs of the Waimangu geothermal system were established within the craters- making the reserve the world's youngest geothermal eco-system. It took 30 years after the eruption for plant life to return. Three of the four walking trails vary from 1.5 to 4km, are mostly flat with some moderate downhill sections, and suitable for most levels of fitness. Enjoy beautiful panoramic views from several viewpoints along the trail. The boat cruise on Lake Rotomahana showcases the valley's geothermal activity from a unique perspective.

Discover the Waimangu Volcanic Valley and Lake Rotomahana with the Full Waimangu Experience. You'll enjoy beautiful walking & hiking trails, woven through a natural geothermal ecosystem. Complete the experience with a 45 minute boat cruise around Lake Rotomahana, the final resting place of the Pink & White Terraces.

Paradise Valley Springs is set in a very natural and well-maintained New Zealand bush environment. There is a freshwater spring onsite that supplies the park with all of its water needs, along with an on display water bottling plant. The Ngongotaha Stream flows throughout Paradise Valley, home to many wild trout. All of the wildlife on display are either wild (both native and introduced) or farmed around New Zealand - with the exception of the African lion pride and for this reason the lions are housed and displayed in a slightly separate area of the park. Hands on or close contact with many of the animals is encouraged.

Enjoy the the Bird, Trout and Wildlife park, as well as the Treetops Walk and the Lion pride.

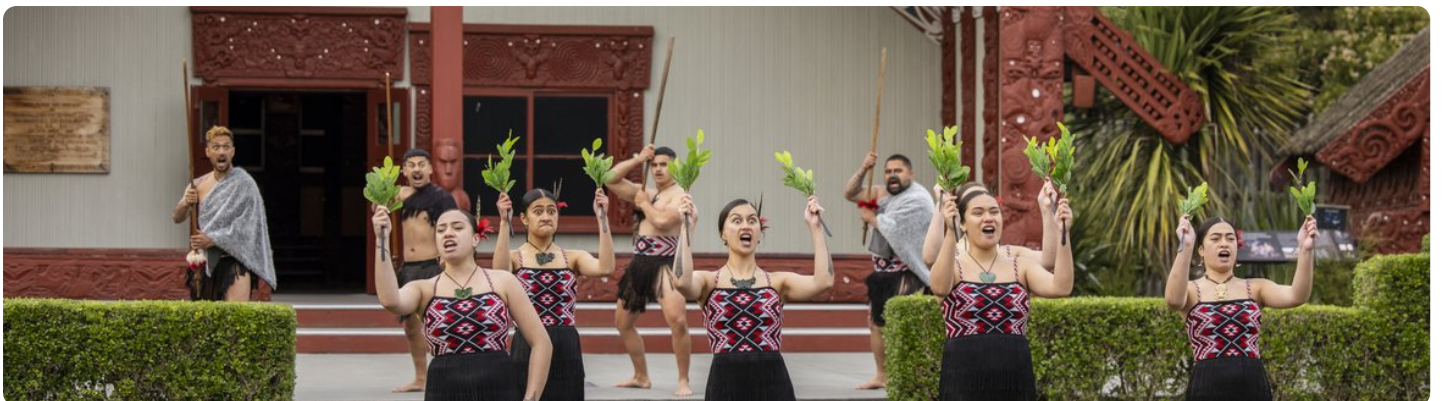

This beautiful evening experience will finish with you enjoying a hot chocolate, seated on a naturally heated rock terrace overlooking the powerful Pōhutu Geyser.
